

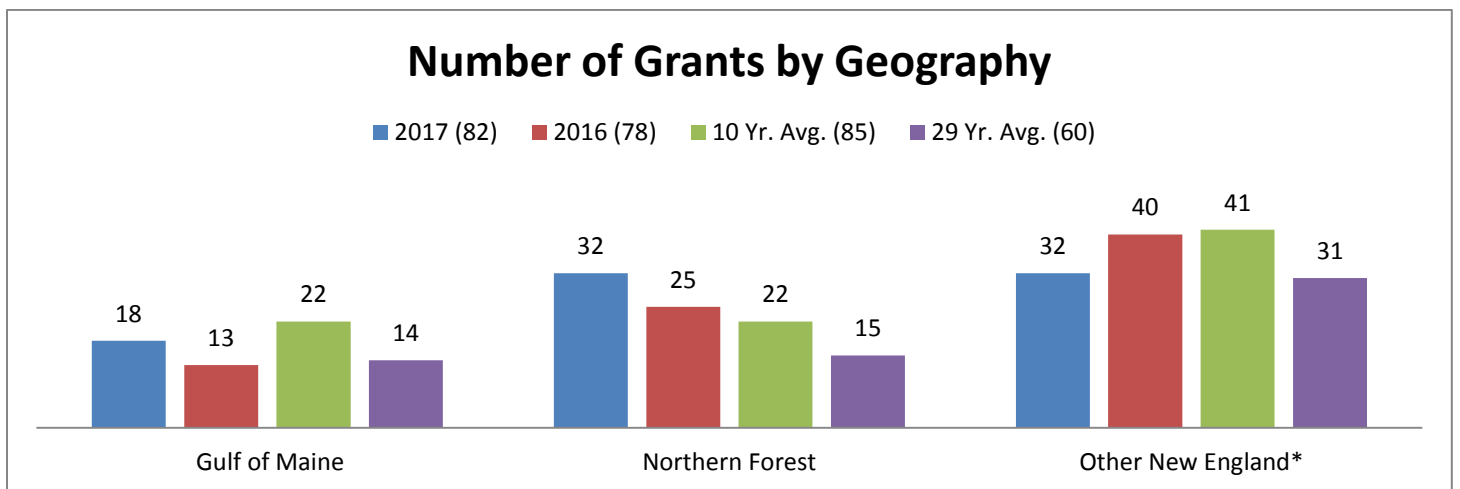
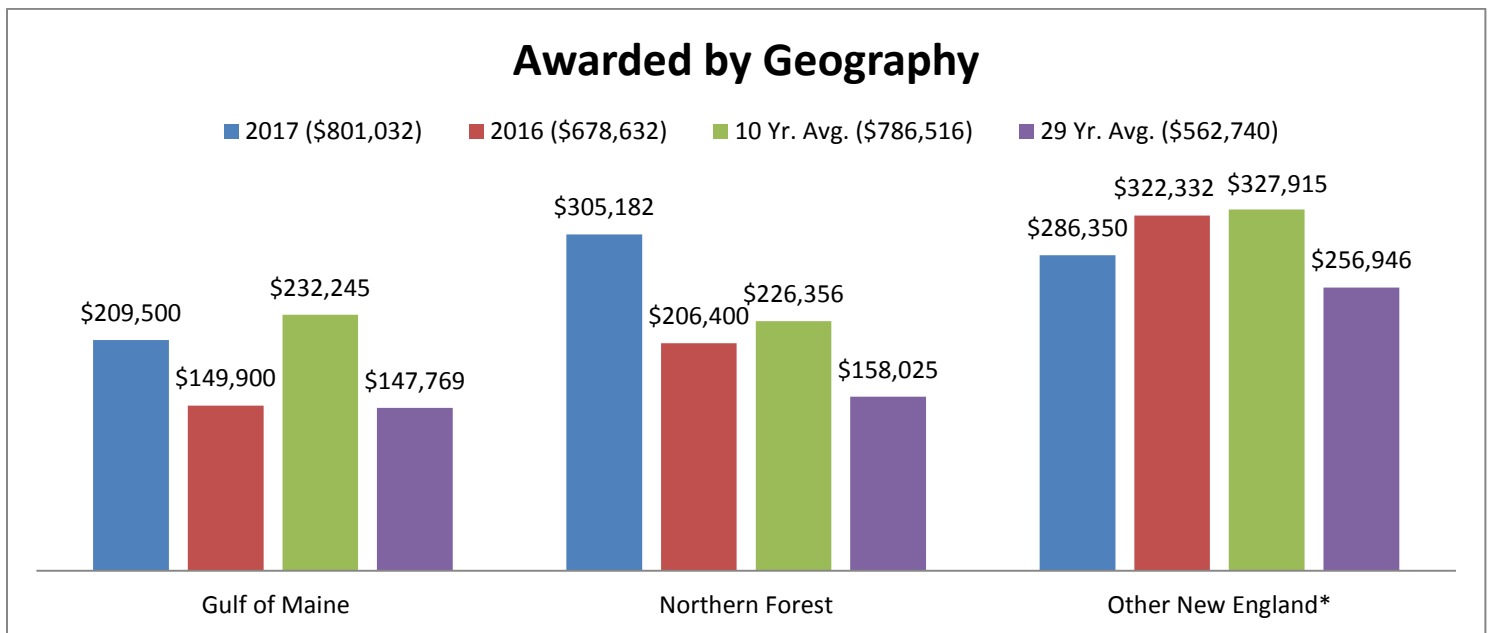

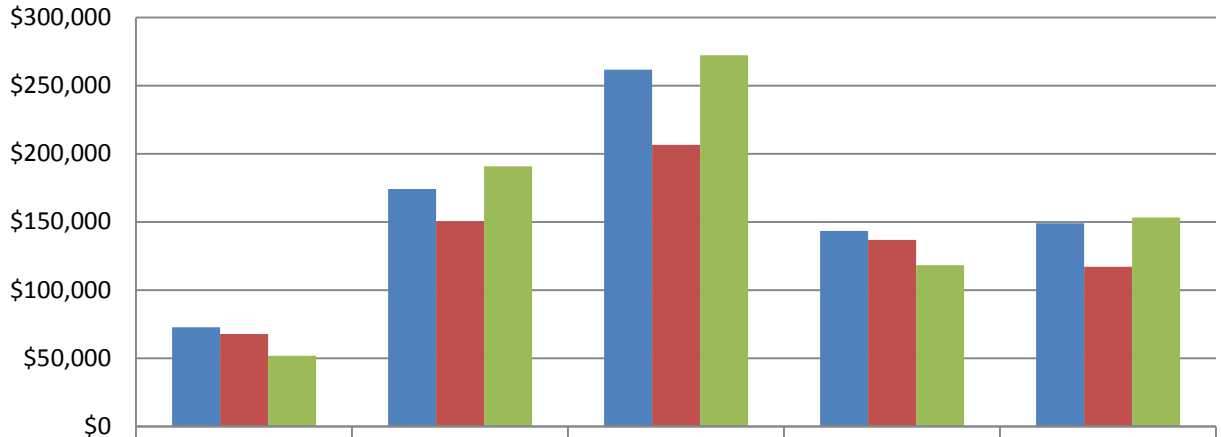
GEOGRAPHY
