

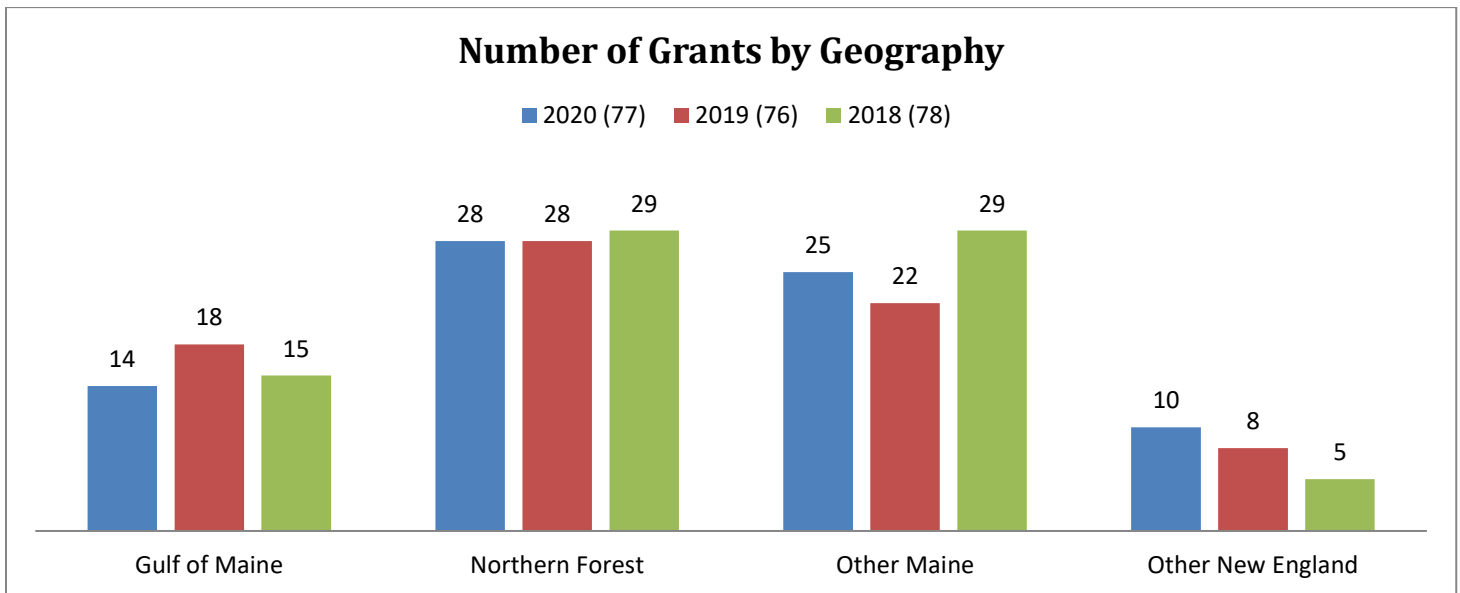

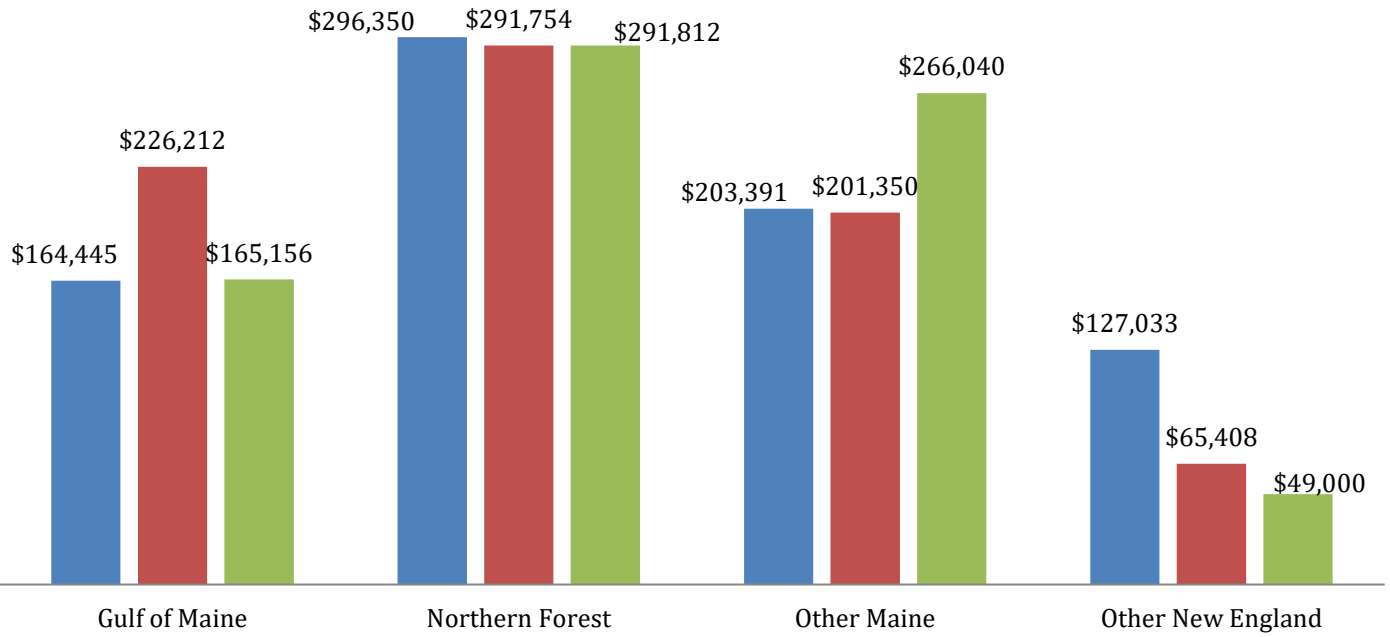
## GEOGRAPHY

## Dollars Awarded by Geography

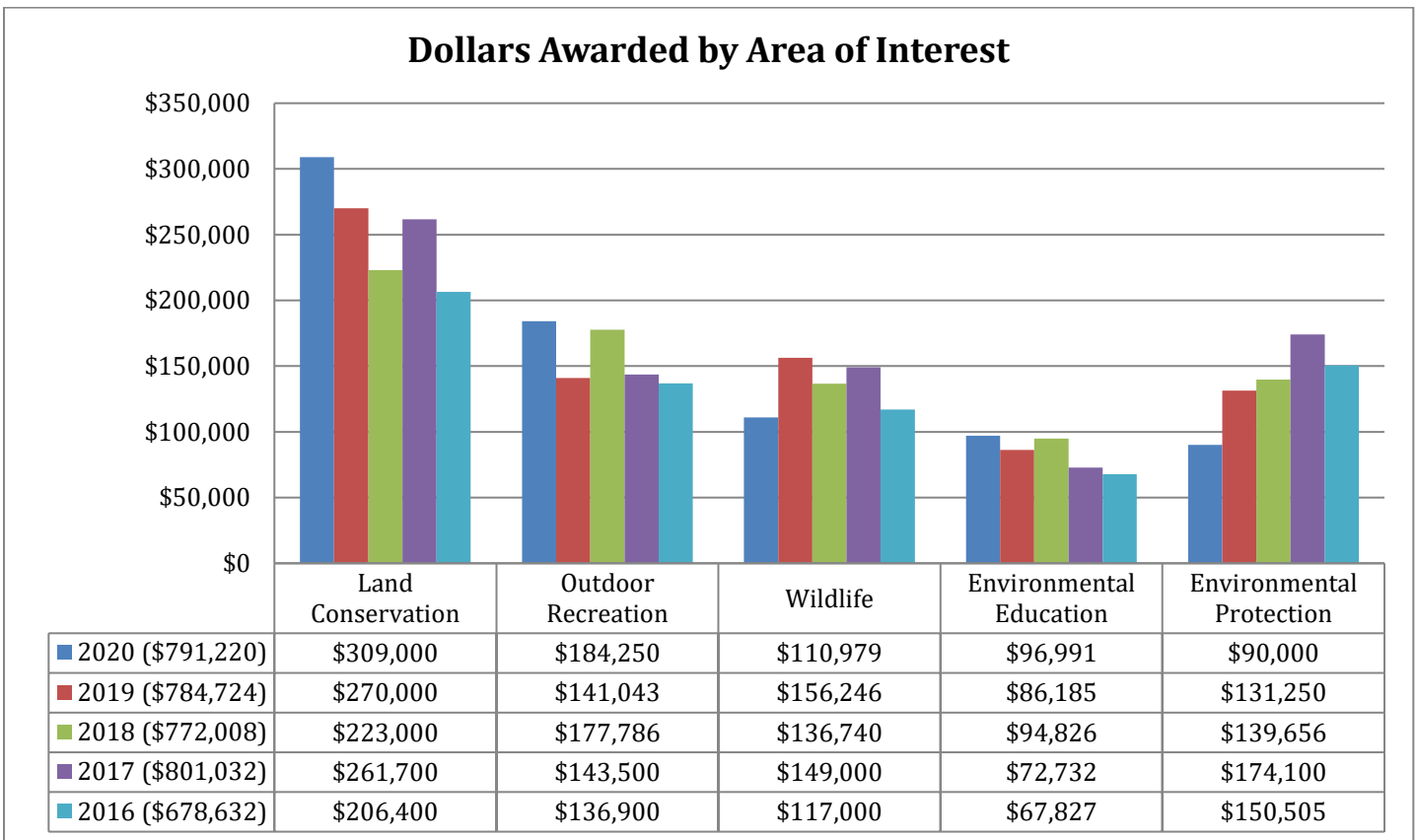
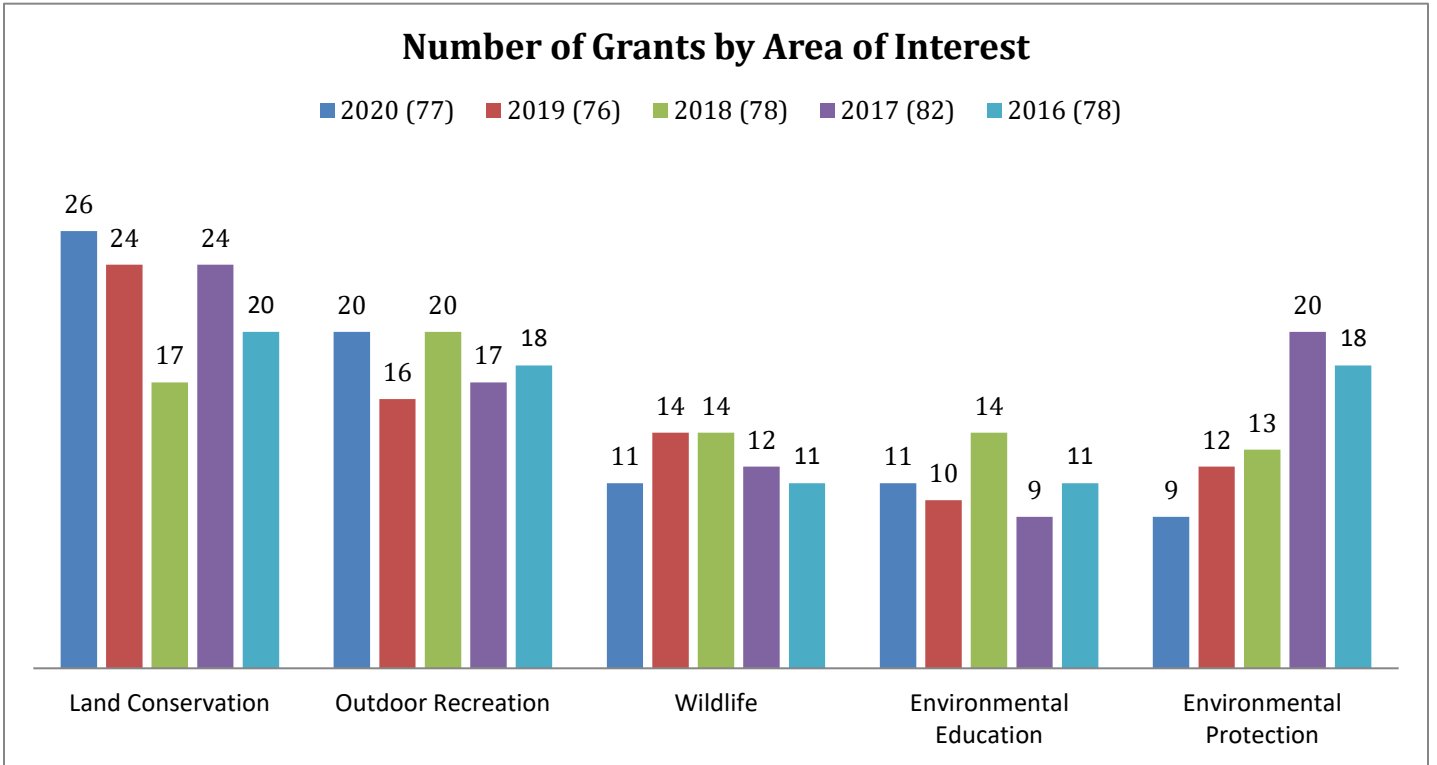
■ 2020 (\$791,220) ■ 2019 (\$784,724) ■ 2018 (\$772,008)
